



Colorado Farm Show Scholarships

(Revised 7/20/21)

The Colorado Farm Show awards the following scholarships to deserving students who strive to leave a lasting impression on their community and in the agriculture industry and who are pursuing an Agricultural Major at a College, University, or Trade School of their choice:

2 – \$4000.00 Colorado Farm Show Rolling Scholarships

A four-year renewable scholarship offered to graduating High School Seniors planning on pursuing a degree in an Agriculture field of study at a four-year College or University. Once awarded a Colorado Farm Show Rolling Scholarship, applicants must annually provide proof of enrollment by JULY 1.

6 - \$2000.00 Chuck Urano Memorial Scholarships

A one-time scholarship awarded to graduating High School Seniors who are planning on pursuing a degree in an Agriculture field of study at a two- or four-year College or University.

2 - \$2000.00 Carl Luther Memorial Vo-Tech Scholarships

A one-time scholarship awarded to graduating High School Seniors who are planning on pursuing a degree in a Vocational field of study at a two-year College or Vo-tech School.

\$1000.00 Colorado Farm Show Scholarship

One-time scholarships awarded to graduating High School Seniors who have volunteered or have family members who have volunteered with the Colorado Farm Show and are planning on pursuing a degree in an Agricultural or Vo-Tech field of study at a two- or four-year College, University, or Vo-Tech School.

2 - \$1500.00 Colorado Farm Show Secondary Scholarships

A scholarship awarded to past Colorado Farm Show Scholarship winners currently pursuing their secondary education in an Agricultural or Vo-Tech Field. A youth can only receive the Secondary Scholarship once.

3. Applicants must be citizens of the United States and reside in Colorado.
4. Students must be pursuing a degree in an Agricultural related field of study at the accredited College, University, or Trade School of their choice.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

1. A sealed, signed copy of the applicant's Official High School Transcripts must accompany the scholarship application. **Senior year classes must be listed if not included on transcripts.**
2. One letter of recommendation from a High School staff member or other non-related adult must be included with the application packet.
3. A one page essay outlining the applicant's educational goals, chosen career plans, and any other information that the applicant considers pertinent must be included with the application.
4. Complete application electronically; print off and acquire needed signatures.
5. Complete application packet must be postmarked to the Colorado Farm Show Office, PO Box 670, Greeley, CO 80632, by **November 1, 2021.**
6. A high-resolution electronic photo of yourself (senior photo or similar) must be emailed to info@coloradofarmshow.com so that it is received by November 1, 2021.

Failure to submit a completed application with all of the required materials will eliminate your application.
